Eggs hatch and now the tadpole can now swim and feed on algae from the pond.

Young tadpoles grow bigger.
They grow legs and as they
grow their tails become
smaller. These are now very
small frogs that can eat
insects and plants.

The small frogs grow into adult frogs and no longer have tails. Frogs eat insects and plants and are able to carry on the life cycle by producing more frog spawn.
